FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINES:

- Summer Semester Scholarships March 1 31
- Fall Semester Scholarships May 1 June 15
- Spring Semester Scholarships October 1 30

FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

- Clark State awards over \$300,000 in scholarships annually.
- More than 50 different scholarships offered through the Foundation.
- Funds are received through private donations from the community to elevate the overall education level of our area.

GEORGE MUELLER TECH PREP SCHOLARSHIP

- Student must complete career tech program in high school with 2.25 GPA; must maintain 2.25 GPA while enrolled at Clark State.
- \$3,000 awarded for 12+ credit hours (\$1,500 per year for two years) or \$2,400 awarded for 8-11 credit hours (\$1,200 per year for two years).
- Scholarship pays for tuition and fees;
 Scholarship is non-refundable.
- Apply and be automatically accepted into Clark State!
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) annually. Other financial aid must be used prior to using the Tech Prep Scholarship.
- Apply via AcademicWorks May 1 June 15.
 Scholarships will be awarded based on available funds.

COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS SCHOLARSHIP

- Up to \$1,000 per semester, for a total of \$3,000 awarded in the first year of college; covers tuition and fees, up to three semesters.
- Student needs to complete at least 30 credit hours through Clark State prior to high school graduation and have a minimum 3.0 GPA; must maintain 3.0 GPA while at Clark State.
- Apply online via AcademicWorks May 1 -June 15. Scholarships will be awarded based on available funds.

TRUSTEE SCHOLARSHIP

- Requirements: 3.5 cumulative GPA in high school and maintain 3.3 GPA while at Clark State.
- Student must maintain full-time status at the College by completing a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester and 30 credit hours by end of summer semester.
- Scholarship includes in-state tuition and fees for 30 credit hours per year for two years.
- Apply online via AcademicWorks May 1 -June 15. Scholarships will be awarded based on available funds.
- A letter of recommendation from guidance counselor or teacher is required.
